rendered with the Punjab State Electricity Board, is to be taken into account as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to re-calculate the pensionary benefits of the petitioner by taking into account the service which the petitioner has rendered with the Punjab State Electricity Board.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that even the full pension qua the period which the petitioner spent in the Jail Department has also not been extended to the petitioner on the basis of some disciplinary proceedings though, the same has already attained finality and there is no impediment in the release of the full pension even qua the said period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-10) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Ashu Kaushik, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-10) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel

further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
