Short affidavit dated 08.11.2024 of Sh. Gursimran Singh Dhillon, Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Land Acquisition Collector, Amritsar, filed on behalf of respondent No. 2, is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite side.

[6] It is made clear that respondent-State of Punjab shall be bound by the stand as taken in the aforesaid affidavit dated 08.11.2024.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
