1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate into the death of Mohammad Kaium aged about 16 years son of Mohammad Akhtar, who was run over by the vehicle driven by respondent No.5 on 03.11.2023 at about 3.45 AM, with a further prayer to register FIR against respondents No.4 and 5 for intentionally killing him.

2. Status report dated 24.01.2024 by way of affidavit of Sukhwinder Pal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar Rural has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that representation dated 10.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) annexed with the present petition was enquired into and the petitioner along with other respectable persons appeared and submitted a

common statement dated 03.11.2023 mentioning therein that they do not want any action on the said representation, as it was mere an accident and no one was at fault, for which General Diary No.30 dated 03.11.2023 was recorded at Police Station Beas, Amritsar. The petitioner has also submitted his affidavit before the jurisdictional police reiterating the same.

4. In view of the above, nothing survives for consideration in the present petition and the same is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
