1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned letter/order dated 23.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) regarding cancellation of appointment of the petitioner issued by respondent No.3.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 14.02.2023, the following order was passed :-

“Counsel for respondent No.3 has brought to the notice of this Court notification dated 12.09.2022 which reads as under:-

“Notification

No.14/7/2019-IDW/I/424292/2022 The Governor of Punjab is pleased to approve the closure of Guardians of Governance (G.O.G) Scheme, which was launched vide Notification No.14/8/2017-

3DW/38, dated 6.9.2017 with immediate effect (i.e. from 9.9.2022). All other Notifications/Committees related to G.O.G. Scheme stand null and void.”

He thus submits that the scheme already stands closed and thus the present writ petition against the cancellation of the appointment has been rendered infructuous.

Copy of the order be served upon the counsel for the petitioner.”

3. No one was present on behalf of the petitioner on 14.02.2023 and today also the position is the same.
4. In view of the fact that vide notification dated 12.09.2022, Guardians of Governance Scheme has already been closed, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
