**RA-CW-533-2019**

1. Present review application has been filed for reviewing the order dated 01.10.2019 by which, the present writ petition was dismissed.
2. On being asked to point out as to which incorrect fact has been noticed so as to dismiss the petition, learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner has not been able to show any such incorrect fact taken into consideration while passing the order dated 01.10.2019.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that in the facts and circumstances of the present case, the applicant-petitioner had a good case and the same should have been allowed.

4. This argument shows that under the garb of the review, the applicant-petitioner wants to re-argue the case before another Bench so as to convince to arrive at a different conclusion than the one arrived at by the Coordinate Bench while passing the order dated 01.10.2019. The liberty of fresh arguments cannot be allowed as the jurisdiction and scope to pass an order under review is very limited.

5. Keeping in view the above, no ground is made out to allow the present review application.
