1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide her representation (Annexure P-10) and directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to conduct fair and independent inquiry in FIR No.0037 dated 18.04.2023 under Sections 452, 323, 427, 149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, after rejecting the cancellation report.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigating agency had filed a cancellation report by ignoring all the material which had been handed over by the petitioner to the investigating agency at the time of the registration of the FIR in question; however, till date no action had been taken on the cancellation report, which was still pending before the authorities concerned. After arguing for some time, learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents to take a decision on the said cancellation



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report at the earliest as the petitioners have been left in a lurch.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar to take a decision on the cancellation report in the FIR in question at the earliest.
