1. Counsel for the petitioners inter alia submits that petitioners belong to muslim religion and they have performed Nikah on 13.10.2024 and both of them are married and this is their first marriage (Nikah). Counsel for the petitioners further submits that respondents No.4 to 6 who are against the aforesaid marriage of the petitioners are extending threats to cause physical harm to the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 24.08.2024 Annexure P-4 is submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. P.K. Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana and on instructions from ASI Devkinandan submits that FIR No.313 dated 19.10.2024, under Sections 140 (3), 351 (2) and Section 3 (5) of BNS 2023 against petitioner No.1 and one Azad on the basis of complaint given by the family members of petitioner No.2. The State counsel further submits that in case, the petitioners have given certain



representation, the same will be looked into and considered by the competent authority at the earliest.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Nuh to consider representation dated 24.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.

6. Pending applications stand disposed of.
