1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') is for issuance of
directions to respondents No.1 & 2 to depute some senior official not below the
rank of Superintendent of Police to conduct enquiry in FIR No.148 dated
21.07.2024 under Sections 108 & 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023,
registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, Patiala and to take appropriate legal
action against respondents No.6 to 9 and one more unknown person after
arresting them, in accordance with law, in view of complaint dated 13.08.2024
(Annexure P-2).

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has substantially been redressed. Respondents No.6 to 9 have already been arrested and the investigating agency would conclude the investigation and present the final report under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*now Section 193 of BNSS*) before the concerned jurisdictional Court, within a period of 08 weeks from today.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file an appropriate application before the jurisdictional Court, if need arises.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
