1. Present petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to proceed against the accused in FIR No.0288 dated 24.10.2024 under Sections 125/351(2)/61 (1)/ BNS, 2023 and Sections 25/27 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar by adding appropriate sections of BNS Act, 2023 because four round were fired upon petitioner and his family members with intention to kill, whereas the petitioner filed a representation dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) for the same as respondent No.3 lodged the FIR after delay of 09 days.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if representation dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) is decided in a time bound manner.

- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

- 6. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) is directed to decide the representation dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.
