DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

- [1] The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.68 dated 04.05.2022 under Sections 18/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.
- [2] It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case of the petitioner is on same footing as that of co-accused Sabir Khan, who has allowed bail vide order dated 17.11.2023 passed in CRM-M-56358-2023 (Annexure P-2). One more co-accused, namely Davinder Singh @ Aviyyt was allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 11.01.2024 passed in CRM-M-54103-2023, copy of which is also placed on record.
- [3] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Harvinder Singh, could not refute to the aforesaid contentions. He has also placed on record the custody certificate, revealing that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year 08 months and 24 days, with no criminal antecedents.

[4] Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, particularly on the basis of parity, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
