1. This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.389 dated 16.11.2020 registered under Sections 147, 149, 294, 323, 427, 452, 506 of IPC and Sections 3(1)(r) and 3(1)(s) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amended 2015) at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hisar, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. This Court vide order dated 08.11.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar and got their statements recorded. It is



also submitted therein that statement of one injured-Pardeek Kumar who has not been named in the petition has also been recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Judge has submitted a copy of report dated 07.12.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.389 dated 16.11.2020 registered under Sections 147, 149, 294, 323, 427, 452, 506 of IPC and Sections 3(1)(r) and 3(1)(s) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amended 2015) at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hisar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
