JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to re-determine seniority list of Craft Instructors possessing higher qualification of three years Diploma in contrast with that of ITI/CTI Certificate holders.

2. The petitioners claim that they possess higher qualification of three years diploma still they have been placed at the fag end of the seniority list and persons having ITI/CTI Certificates have been placed higher than them. They have served representation/demand notice dated 13.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) upon the respondent seeking prescription of separate quota of Crafts Instructors with qualification of three years but to no avail.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that grievance of the petitioners, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to

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consider their representation/demand notice dated 13.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Gurpartap Singh Bhullar, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondent-State, assures the Court that competent authority would look into grievance of the petitioners and advert to representation/demand notice dated 13.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) within three months from today.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to adjudicate representation/demand notice dated 13.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners within three months from today.
