This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of the order dated 12.09.2023 passed by this Court in CRWP-9081-2022.

Compliance affidavit by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 has been filed by learned counsel for the respondents today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the claim of the petitioner has been duly looked into and it has been found that the petitioner does not have any threat perception. Hence, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
