MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detainees mentioned in para 2 of the petition.

2. In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, response by way of affidavit dated 29.11.2023 of Sh. Surender Kumar, HPS Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nuh has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy of the same be supplied to the other side during the course of the day.

3. For reference, para 4 of the aforesaid affidavit is recapitulated as under:-

“4. That it is also submitted that during the course of enquiry some other employees posted on the aforesaid Brick Kiln were also joined in the enquiry proceedings and they have also specifically contended that the persons mentioned in para No.2 of the petition have visited the aforesaid Brick Kiln, but they have returned back to their houses and none of them is working on M/s Taj Brick Kiln. No wages of any person is due towards the owner of the kiln. A copy of the enquiry report conducted by ASI Rajesh Kumar P.S.

Sadar Nuh is annexed as Annexure R-3. Hence, the order passed by the Hon’ble Court stands complied with.”

Perusal of aforesaid extract reveals that all the alleged detenues have returned back to their houses and none of them is working with M/s Taj Brick Kiln.

- 4. In view of the above, present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
- 5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
