1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner no.1 a female aged more than 18 years is living with petitioner no.2 a male aged more than 19 years with her free will and consent that both the petitioners are unmarried and their live in relationship is opposed by respondents No.4 to 7 who are extending threats to cause harm to them and to this effect, representation dated 04.11.2024 Annexure P-3 is submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of

Police, Yamuna Nagar to consider representation dated 04.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 7 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
