This petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India has been filed seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner(s) at the hands of private respondent No.6 who is demanding illegal ransom (arrayed in the petition) and take action on their representations dated 07.10.2024 and 28.10.2024 (Annexures P3 & P4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have filed a representations dated 07.10.2024 and 28.10.2024 (Annexures P3 & P4) before respondent No.5 raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.5, to consider and decide the aforesaid representations filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereupon.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. R.S. Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.5 to consider and decide the aforesaid representations dated 07.10.2024 and 28.10.2024 (Annexures P3 & P4) of the petitioners expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioners, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
