By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner
prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.53 dated 12.06.2023 registered
under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

It is informed by learned State Counsel and as also mentioned in the
status report that prosecution has already concluded its evidence. Even the
