The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.340 dated 28.10.2023 registered under Sections 3, 4, 5, 7 & 8 of Immoral Trafficking (Prevention Act, 1956 and Sections 374 and 120-B IPC P.S. B Division, Amritsar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 30.11.2023 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 30.11.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 30.11.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
