1. Affidavit dated 10.01.2024 of Rakesh Kumar, Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Sangrur, Punjab filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5 is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.
2. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 11.08.2023 (Annexure P-18) whereby respondent No.2 has rejected the justice demand notice submitted by the petitioner.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.2 has calculated pension of the petitioner without taking care of revised pay scale. The respondent No.2 in its reply in para 7 has admitted that pension of employees who retired prior to 31.12.2015 is being revised by concerned bank.
4. Mr. Inderpreet Singh Kang, AAG, Punjab submits that in view of stand taken in para 7 of the reply, the needful shall be done expeditiously and preferably within 6 months from today.
5. In the wake of statements of both side, the present petition stands disposed of.
