This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 02.11.2023 passed in CWP-24610-2023.

Reply dated 10.01.2024 by way of affidavit of Gaurav Yadav, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector 9, Chandigarh, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.

Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 02.11.2023 passed in CWP-24610-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if she feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
