1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for grant of 'regular bail' to the present petitioner in case FIR No.15, dated 29.01.2024, under Sections 21 and 29 of the the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1).

2. A custody certificate has been filed by the learned State counsel *qua* the petitioner today in court, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant the asked for relief of 'regular bail' to the present petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be
