However, in case, any claim of the petitioners still survives, they would be at liberty to raise their claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from the release of payments, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioners within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to each of the petitioners from his / her own pocket.
