This is the first petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation and take appropriate speedy legal action against private respondents i.e. respondent Nos.5 to 11 in case bearing FIR No.135 dated 29.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 34, 365, 376-D, 452 and 506 IPC and Section 67-B of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Women, District Nuh (Mewat) to any other independent investigating agency or any other senior police officials not below the IPS rank.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, on instructions from PSI Poonam, submits that one of the accused has been acquitted by the learned trial Court on 22.07.2022 and the trial is under progress qua the other accused, in which, out of total 18 prosecution witnesses, 10 have already been examined.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
