1. Instant petition under Article 226 has been preferred seeking directions to the respondents to extend the period of parole already granted, from 12.10.2024 to 10.11.2024.

2. Heard.

3. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is lodged in District Jail Nuh, in case FIR as mentioned below: -

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner had been granted concession of parole from 12.10.2024 to 10.11.2024 on medical grounds and the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 29.10.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent,



District Jail Nuh for extension of parole for the aforesaid period which has yet not been decided.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 4 to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-3) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

6. Notice of motion.

7. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 4 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be dealt with and disposed of in an expeditious manner as per law.

8. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 4-the Superintendent, District Jail Nuh (Mewat), to consider the averments made in the representation dated 29.10.2024 (Annexure P-3), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

9. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
