1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the remaining amount of Rs.2,47,24,623/- alongwith interest @18% per annum, to the petitioner towards the compulsory acquisition of his land.
2. The respondents have now approached the Commissioner-cum-Arbitrator challenging the award, where the interim order has been passed in favour of the respondents.
3. In view of the above, learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the points, as raised in the present petition, before the Arbitrator, alongwith other pleas available to him, but in accordance with law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
