The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.240 dated 16.06.2023 under Section 420, 120-B IPC and Section 61, 4, 20 (Act No.1) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill 2020) and Section 192, 192-A, 196 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Narual.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 30.11.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 30.11.2023 but has not co-operated in the investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail, I see no reason to decline bail to the petitioner, more so when he has joined the investigation.

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In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.11.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
