The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.102, dated 12.09.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 333, 351(2), 191(3),190 of BNS,2023, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 12.11.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
