DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

(1) The present intra court has been filed by the Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. (for short - the Nsigam) to challenge judgment dated 30.08.2018 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court allowing the respondent's writ petition through which compassionate appointment had been claimed.

(2) A perusal of the interim orders passed in the instant appeal show that on 10.01.2023 learned counsel appearing for both the parties were *ad idem* that the present appeal be disposed of in terms of the judgment of the Supreme Court dated 13.01.2020 passed in ***Civil Appeal No.2144 of 2016 - Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Ltd. and others Vs. Kelo Devi and another.***



(3) It was further agreed that in terms of the ***Kelo Devi's*** case (supra) learned counsel for the appellants shall calculate the *ex-gratia* payment payable to the respondent under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 (for short - 2006 Rules).

(4) Today Mr. Deepak Balyan, Advocate has produced details of the amount already paid to the respondent under the 2006 Rules. Such calculations have also been shared with learned counsel for the respondent. These calculations are taken on record as Annexure-‘X’.

(5) In the light of the above, the instant appeal is disposed of.

(6) If there is any mathematical error in the calculations, the respondent would be at liberty to approach the appellants for the correction thereof.

(7) All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
