KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for directing the official respondents No.2 to 4, to ensure the protection of lives and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6, and further to restrain them from interfering into the peaceful lives of the petitioners.

2. This Court, on dated 07.11.2024, had passed the hereinafter extracted order, upon the instant petition :-

“Petitioner No.1, who is already married with respondent No.5 and having one girl child from that wedlock and without getting dissolved the earlier marriage, walked out from the matrimonial relationship and started living with petitioner No.2, who is stated to be unmarried, in a “live-in relationship”, has approached this Court having apprehension to their life and liberty.

Notice of motion.



Mr. Pardeep Bajaj, DAG, Punjab, waives service on behalf of the respondent No.1 to 4.

Notice to respondents No. 5 and 6 be issued for 27.11.2024 on furnishing of requisite process fee.

Dasti as well.

In the meantime, the State is directed to evaluate the threat perception, if any, and file status report on or before the next date of hearing.”

3. In deference to the directions, issued by this Court, vide order dated 07.11.2024, status report dated 26.11.2024, by way of affidavit of Mr. Manjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sardulgarh, District Mansa, on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3, furnished by the learned State counsel today in the Court. The same is taken on the record.
4. A thorough enquiry was conducted and from the enquiry itself it reflects that there is no threat perception to the petitioners, as on today. Furthermore, during the enquiry, the statement of the petitioners were also got recorded, whereby, they stated before the Enquiry Officer, that they do not have any threat perception, or danger to their lives, from the private respondents, as on date.
5. In view of the above, the asked for relief cannot be granted. Therefore, the instant criminal writ petition is **dismissed**.
