The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.22 dated 21.03.2024 under Section 306 of IPC registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh, submits that petitioner has got the interim order by concealing the material facts. The petitioner was declared as proclaimed person vide order dated 29.10.2024 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Zira and this fact was not brought to the notice of this Court when the case was listed on 07.11.2024, as such, in view of the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in 'Lavesh v. State (NCT of Delhi)' (2012) 8 SCC 730 and 'Vipan Kumar Dhir v. State of Punjab and another', 2021 (4) R.C.R. (Criminal) 378, the present petition is not maintainable.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition after challenging the order dated 29.10.2024 vide which the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
