The relief is regarding appointment to the post of Punjab Civil Services (Judicial Branch) and the challenge is to the Rule 7 (2) of the Punjab Civil Service (Judicial) Branch Rules, 1951, whereby the minimum marks are prescribed for coming in the zone of consideration, which the petitioner apparently failed regarding the selection of 2016. None has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Apparently, the petitioner seems to have lost the interest in the litigation, as counsel had not put in appearance on 01.05.2023 also.

2. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
