1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.275 dated 01.09.2023 under Sections 34, 406, 420 of the IPC registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.
2. Vide order dated 01.12.2023, the parties had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement.
3. Report has since been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. As per the report, the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement vide compromise dated 08.01.2024.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, does not oppose the prayer made by the petitioner for extending the concession of anticipatory bail to him.

5. In the circumstances, it is directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petition stands allowed subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
