1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.78 dated 29.08.2024 registered under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 324(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS (offence under Section 118(2) of BNS, 2023 added lateron), at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.11.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
