AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (Oral)

1. The prayer in the present Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for directing the respondents to consider and pay the (Essentiality Certificate) for mediclaim of Rs.803268.08 of petitioners in physical mode instead of online RGHS Portal of respondents.

2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is in receipt of letter dated 25.01.2023 (Annexure P-4), as per which he has to upload the medical bill on RGHS (Rajasthan Government Health Service) Portal, however, the same is not working. Therefore, he being 75 years old pensioner seeking legal medical reimbursement, residing in Mohali (Punjab), would be satisfied, if a direction is given to the respondents to accept the medical bills of the petitioner in a physical mode.

3. There is no representation on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, despite service.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case, the petitioner submits medical bills in a physical mode within a period of four weeks, the same shall be dealt with, in accordance with law.
