1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 10.03.2023 passed in CWP-1442-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Vidhyasagari R.U., IFS, Divisional Forest Officer, Forest Division, Patiala, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 10.03.2023 passed in CWP-1442-2023 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 02.01.2024 (Annexure R-3/1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the aforesaid speaking order passed by the concerned respondent/authority.
