The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.351 dated 05.10.2023, registered under Sections 21(b), later on added Section 29 of NDPS Act and Sections 42 and 52-A Prison Act, at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.12.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
