The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 18.09.2024 (P-8), whereby respondent No.2 has declined the request of the petitioner for grant of permission/no objection for acquiring higher qualification and study leave.
