1 By way of this petition, the petitioners are seeking direction to respondent No.2 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

2 On the last date, status report has been filed by respondent Nos.1 to 3, wherein it is stated as under:-

“5. That thereafter, on the same day (04.01.2024), 10 reached at the house of respondent No. 6 Gurdas son of Tella Ram resident of village Tobha District-Ambala to verify about the facts of present case and recorded his statement, in which apart from the other facts, he has stated that "I have four children out of which three are girls and one boy. I have married my elder daughter, my son Sunil Kumar has been handicapped since childhood and who works as a barber, my son, is beyond listening to what I say. I have evicted my son from the movable or immovable property. In future, if my son Sunil Kumar

does any kind of transaction or quarrel, my Sunil Kumar himself will be held responsible. I and my family have no relation with Sunil Kumar, about which I have also published a news item in Dainik Savera Times newspaper on dated 22.08.2022 regarding the eviction of my son Sunil Kumar from his movable and immovable property. A copy of which I have presented to you. Now I have received documents from the Honorable Punjab and Haryana High Court that my son Sunil Kumar is in live in relationship with Kiran Bala. That my evicted sons Sunil Kumar and Kiran Bala are living together in live in relationship. About which I have no objection because I have already evicted my son and who is 32 years old and who is a major and can take his own decisions about his future. My sons Sunil Kumar and Kiran Bala are living in a live-in relationship of their own free will and I do not know where they are living. My son Sunil Kumar has prepared the documents of love in relationship. I and my family have no objection regarding this live in relationship, nor will I trouble Sunil Kumar or Kiran Bala in any way in future. I have got recorded my statement to you and heard it which is fine. The copy of same is annexed as Annexure R-1 for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

6. That thereafter, on the same day (04.01.2024) IO reached at the house of Deep Chand, son of Laxman Das, resident of village Talakaur police station Chappar, district Yamunanagar, and joined him in the inquiry of the present matter and recorded his statement, in which, apart from the other facts, he has has stated that I do work as a labourer. I was married in the year 2010 with Kiran Bala, R/o village, Nurd police station, Mullana, according to Hindu rites and customs. From this marriage, I have two sons, both are studying, by my wife Kiran Bala is out of his control and not paying any heed his words. She used to act as per her own wish and used to leave the house without telling anything. When I explained it to my wife, she would not listen to me. Due to

which there used to be discord between me and my wife. My wife had left the house without informing me for the last several days and I was personally searching for her. I have received document from the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh that my wife had voluntarily left with Sunil Kumar r/o Village Toba and have got prepared the documents in the Court regarding living in a live-in-relationship. My wife is 38 years old and is a major who can take her own decisions about her future. Kiran Bala is living in live relationship with Sunil Kumar r/o Village Toba of her own free will. About which I don't know where she is living. I and my family have no objection to being in a live in relationship with my wife Kiran Bala or Sunil Kumar r/o Toba, nor will I trouble Sunil Kumar or Kiran Bala in any way in the future. I have got recorded my statement to you and heard it which is fine. The copy of which is annexed as Annexure R-2 for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court."

3 Since the respondent Nos.5 and 6 undertake not to trouble petitioners in any way in future, the said statement satisfies counsel for the petitioners.

4 In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed off.
