1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing notice of agenda meeting dated 03.12.2019, Annexure P-5.

Counsel for respondents No.5 and 6 submits that during the pendency of the petition, office bearers to The Mehsampur Co-operative Agriculture Society, respondent No.5, have been elected and their term is likely to expire by the end of this year. He submits that the petitioner had a remedy of election petition, which he has not availed of.
