Learned counsel for the petitioner informs, which fact is not denied by learned State counsel, that the offence of murder has been registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh, vide FIR No. 176 dated 13.11.2024 under Sections 103 (1) and 238 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Since the grievance raised in this petition by the petitioner, who happens to be father of deceased Gurcharan Singh, is of non-registration of FIR, which appears to have been satisfied now, the cause raised herein has become infructuous.

3. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed as having rendered infructuous.
