This is an application for correction of the date of birth of petitioners no.1 and 2. It is stated that in para 2 of the main petition, the date of birth of petitioner no.1 has wrongly been mentioned as 9.5.2004 whereas her correct date of birth is 28.6.2004 and the date of birth of petitioner no.2 has also wrongly been mentioned as 27.1.2024 whereas his correct date of birth is 7.4.2004. In support thereof, the petitioners have already attached copies of their Aadhar Cards in the main petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively.

In view of the above, the application is allowed and the dates of birth of the petitioners are ordered to be corrected in para 2 of the main

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petition. Registry is directed to carry out the necessary corrections accordingly.

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1. Petitioners-Prabhdeep Kaur and Kunal have filed present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

2. It is submitted that both petitioners are major. As per Aadhaar Card of petitioner No. 1, Annexure P-1, her date of birth is 28.6.2004. As per Aadhaar Card of petitioner No. 2, Annexure P-2, his date of birth is 7.4.2004. It is stated that they are in live-in-relationship without consent and wishes of family members/relatives of petitioner No. 1 and as such they are receiving threats from respondents No. 4 to 7. It is further stated that as and when petitioner no.2-boy attains the marriageable age, both the petitioners will get married. The petitioners have already moved representations dated 3.11.2024 and 6.11.2024 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and SHO, P.S. Gardhiwala, District Hoshiarpur.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

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4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3-State. Complete copy of paper-book along with supporting documents is already supplied.

5. Considering nature of litigation, no purpose would be served by serving notice to private respondents.

6. I have considered the facts narrated in petition, according to which both petitioners are major and they are in live-in-relationship without consent and wishes of family members/relatives of petitioner No. 1 and as such they are receiving threats from respondents No. 4 to 7. As and when petitioner no.2-boy attains the marriageable age, both the petitioners will get married. It is duty of police to protect life of petitioners. Therefore, respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to consider representations of petitioners dated 3.11.2024 and 6.11.2024 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and protect life of petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7, considering threat perception, with further direction to maintain their privacy and dignity.

7. Aforesaid protection order will have no bearing in case there is any violation of law or pending legal proceedings.

8. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
