Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 was similarly situated as petitioner No.2 Jagtar Singh and was entitled for the same benefit as extended to petitioner No.2 hence, the petitioner No.1 be also granted the benefit of promotion as given to petitioner No.2-Jagtar Singh, who is a similarly situated employee.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received at the hands of the petitioner No.1 claiming the said benefit, the same will be decided in accordance with law and appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks and in case, the petitioner No.1 is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be granted to him otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and

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necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage with liberty to file representation with the authorities concerned.
