The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate order or direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 for taking appropriate action for the redressal of the grievance of the petitioner and further a direction may be issued for making compliance of order dated 17.08.2023 (Annexure P-7), issued by respondent Nos.2 and 3 regarding the protection of the land of Gram Panchayat.

At the outset, learned State counsel has filed status report dated 10.02.2024, by way of an affidavit of Harkrishan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Rural, District Patkankot, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4-State, which is taken on record and submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner, in the present petition has been substantially redressed and a DDR No.9 dated 07.07.2023 has also been registered and both

the parties were called to the police station and further, a specific stand is taken in the status report that whenever, the revenue department, with regard to the dispute, will seek police assistance, the same will be provided.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of in view of the status report filed by the State of Punjab.

Present petition stands disposed of in the above said terms.
