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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in respect of offence(s) of extortion, organized crime and criminal intimidation in case FIR No. 397 dated 08.10.2024 under Sections 61(2), 308(4), 111(2)(a), 111(2)(b) and 351(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 and 25(6) of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station, Sector 17 HUDA, Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.
2. A reading of the order dated 25.10.2024 of the Court below declining anticipatory bail to the petitioner reveals that the other co-accused, namely, Arun Kumar, Gurmit, Romil and Rudraksh Mehta @ Rohit have since been arrested, but the petitioner was implicated by one Amit Kumar who made a complaint on 30.09.2024 to the extent that the petitioner threatened him to



pay extortion money failing which he and his family members would face dire consequences.

3. The investigation is at an infant stage and the petitioner has antecedents comprising of nearly 16 cases in regard to which no explanation has been given by the petitioner.

4. Considering the overall facts and circumstances, this Court declines the prayer for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. The petition, accordingly, stands dismissed.
