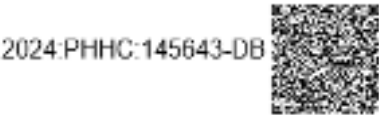

- 1 Prayer in this petition is for directing respondents to afford the benefit of parole to petitioner for a period of two weeks to enable him to attend the marriage of his nephew (Bhanja) to be solemnized on 17.11.2024.
- 2 Heard.
- 3 Petitioner who was convicted in case FIR No.64 dated 09.02.2020, under Section 302 and 34 IPC and 27(1) & 30 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sector-10, Gurugram, it is stated is entitled to concession of parole for the purpose as sought. Application dated 27.10.2024 in this respect has been submitted but the same has not been decided till date.

4 Learned counsel for State, at this stage, points out that application attached as Annexure P2 is not the application which has been submitted before the authorities.

5 Be that as it may, we do not find any ground to interfere at this stage. In the given factual matrix petition, at this stage, is disposed of with a direction to Competent Authority to treat the present petition as an application/representation on behalf of petitioner for the concession of parole and to decide the same in accordance with law expeditiously and definitely by 13.11.2024 by passing a speaking order.
