SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed this petition invoking the inherent powers of this Court under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 in FIR No. 259 dated 15.09.2024 under Sections 103 (1), 190, 191 (3) of BNS registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat, on account of the fact that the investigation is not being conducted in a free, fair and expeditious manner.
2. The petitioner has an alternative remedy under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 175 of BNSS) and Section 200 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 223 of BNSS) before the Magistrate of the area concerned which can very well be invoked by him.
3. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed of.
