This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 22.08.2023 passed in CWP-16455-2018.

Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 22.08.2023 passed in CWP-16455-2018 has been complied with and the Commission has recommended the name of the petitioner for the post of HVD.
