KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.184 dated 31.08.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 506, 307, 294 of IPC and Section 30 of Arms Act, at Police Station Gurgaon City, District Gurugram.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that on the last date of hearing, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the police. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that in compliance of the said order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and even otherwise, the matter stands compromised with the complainant- Rakesh and injured eye witness Satish and further no fire arm injury was

caused at the time of alleged incident.

3. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Dheeraj has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation in this case. The power of attorney filed by Mr. Naveen Kumar, Advocate on behalf of the complainant and injured eye witness is taken on record.

4. Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant submits that the parties have effected compromise and the complainant and injured eye witness are having no objection if the present petition is allowed.

5. In light of the above, without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 02.12.2023 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
