The petitioner is aggrieved against the decision taken by the respondents vide memo dated 25.10.2024, Annexure P-10, declining his request for extension in service on account of being disabled due to not submitting a valid disability certificate in accordance with government instructions, dated 21.04.2008, duly verified by the Medical Board of PGIMS, Rohtak.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to be assessed by a duly constituted Medical Board in terms of the government instructions, and will approach the Director of PGIMS, Rohtak, for the purpose within next seven days.

3. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of with a direction to the respondents, including the Director of PGIMS, Rohtak, to constitute a Medical Board to assess the petitioner's disability, in the event of his approaching him within next seven days, and forward the disability report to the second respondent who shall take a decision regarding extension of



service of the petitioner from fifty-eight to sixty years in terms of the applicable instructions within two weeks therefrom.
