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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner, who is the complainant and has lodged FIR No. 343, dated 23.07.2022 under Sections 307, 343, 341, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 in Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa, has filed this petition invoking the inherent powers of this Court under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 for seeking a direction to the respondent-authorities to conduct fair and impartial investigation.
2. Thus, the grievance of the petitioner appears to be that the investigation triggered by the FIR is not being conducted in a free, fair and expeditious manner.
3. The petitioner can always approach the concerned Magistrate under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure



(Section 175 of BNSS) for the said purpose for which liberty is extended to the petitioner.

4. With the aforesaid liberty, this Court without commenting on merits of the matter disposes of the present petition.
